RAM Clinic
 In April, Head Start organized the first RAM (Rural Area Medical) Clinic in Spencer which provided free eye care including glasses, dental cleanings, fillings and extractions to 712 people!! These services are performed by volunteers who donate their time, and RAM who provides materials. The total value of services was \$134,220!!  We passed our last Federal review with flying colors! We are also accredited with the prestigious National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC). We receive the highest rating of three stars from the State's Three Start program. We are proud to have had this rating since the inception of the state's STAR licensing program! All of our documents are available for public inspection.

Head Start is operated by the Upper Cumberland Human Resource Agency (UCHRA) in Cookeville, Tn. In addition to the Federal Grant of \$325,855 for Head Start, UCHRA Van Buren Co. Head Start also receives \$18,878 from the U.S. Department of Agriculture as reimbursement for the cost of food used in Head Start. We also receive \$97,151 in kind as donations from parents, families and community businesses and individuals!

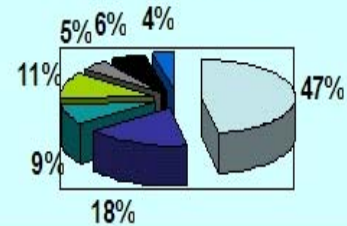

Uchra Van Buren Co. Head Start operates two classrooms in this isolated community. We are licensed to serve 40 children. Each class has a teacher and a co-teacher. We have a Family/Community Partnership Specialist that works with families providing social services as well as organizing parent involvement activities and developing community involvement through partnerships. We also have a Health Services Specialist for health and disability services. The Family Service Worker/Transition Specialist coordinates literacy programs and transitions children to kindergarten. Our children have their meals cooked on-site and are served family style until they are ready for kindergarten transition. Meals are then served cafeteria style to introduce children as to what they can expect in public school. Our food is nutritious, designed to appeal to pre-schoolers and is low fat, low sodium and low sugar.

At UCHRA Van Buren Co. Head Start, we carefully assess our students to keep track of where they are scholastically. We are working very hard to help children to continue to improve and are adding more curriculum in Science and Math. One way we are achieving this is by incorporating the computers we received from a grant. These Little Tykes computers, made possible through donations from IBM and PACER, are loaded with software that is child friendly, teaching students math and science skills while they have fun!

At Head Start, we have 17 Literacy programs which many involve the whole family. We also help children to develop socially and emotionally, helping them to acquire a strong sense of self to become confident, learn self control and cooperate with others. Children are taught good practices such as handwashing and good dental hygiene. We have a dental program which educates children to take care of their teeth. We encourage physical exercise and have a great playground with many activities to enjoy.
